2. Information from your interactions with Outdoor Insurance Group, Inc. (OIG), such as your account numbers, policy numbers, account balances, transaction history and other financial information.
3. Information that we receive from a consumer-reporting agency to ensure the accuracy of account data, driver information or to assess credit worthiness as it applies to underwriting requirements.

**Our Commitment:**

We do not disclose any nonpublic personal information about you to nonaffiliated third parties except as permitted by law. In order to service your insurance needs and to effect transactions that you request or authorize, we will provide your nonpublic personal information to insurance companies that provide insurance products and services on your behalf. We require these outside companies to protect the confidentiality of your information and to use the information only for the purpose for which the disclosure is made.
